MONUMENT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

MODELS A1NB, A1NBF, IPNB, IPNBF, SSBNB, SSBNBF

MATERIALS REQUIRED FOR SETTING MONUMENT:

1. Monument
2. Shovel
3. Post Hole Digger
4. Work gloves and proper eye protection and clothing
5. Fine-grained washed or play sand
6. Steel stamp set
7. DEEP-1™ Magnetic Marker (*OPTIONAL*)
8. Concrete mix (*OPTIONAL*)

IMPORTANT: Prior to installation, stamp as much information on the marker as possible.

1. Dig a hole, no greater than six inches in diameter, using a post hole digger or shovel to desired depth at installation site - minimum desired depth should be monument length + 1" (25mm).
2. **OPTIONAL STEP:** INSTALL DEEP-1™ MAGNETIC MARKER IN BOTTOM OF HOLE (this provides for a subsurface mark as a precaution against the monument being moved or destroyed).
3. **OPTIONAL STEP:** THROW A SMALL AMOUNT OF DRY CONCRETE MIX INTO BOTTOM OF HOLE (moisture from soil will harden dry concrete mix).
4. Carefully insert monument into bottom of hole. Rotate monument to fix into soil.
5. **BACKFILL:** Pack soil around monument and tamp thoroughly for positive compaction. (WE RECOMMEND USING A FINE-GRAINED SAND SUCH AS PLAY SAND FOR MAXIMUM COMPACTION AND PROPER DRAINAGE. THIS MATERIAL WILL ALSO PROVIDE A NEUTRAL MATERIAL TO ACT AS A BUFFER BETWEEN THE MONUMENT AND THE SURROUNDING SOIL).
6. You must properly compact all four (4) sides firmly to insure horizontal and vertical stability.

CAUTION: Care should be taken when working with the notched base end of the monument. We recommend the use of gloves when handling the notched base end of these monuments.

REMEMBER: "Any Monument Is Only As Stable As Its Backfill".
